

FIRE DANGER!

Stage 1 Fire Restrictions

You Can Help! Follow these restrictions:

SHOOTING

PROHIBITED: Use of explosives including but not limited to blasting caps, rockets, exploding targets and tracers or incendiary ammunition. (The use of fireworks, flares or other incendiary devices is **ALWAYS** prohibited on federal lands).

CAMPFIRES

PROHIBITED: Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, including charcoal briquette fire.

PERMITTED: You **CAN** have a campfire (including charcoal briquette fire) within permanent fire rings at established campgrounds and picnic areas.



SMOKING

PROHIBITED: Smoking while traveling in timber, brush or grass areas.

PERMITTED: Smoking within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is cleared of all flammable materials.



OTHER RESTRICTIONS

PROHIBITED: Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine **WITHOUT** a spark-arresting device installed.

PERMITTED: Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine **WITH** a spark-arresting device installed.



PROHIBITED: Blasting, welding or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame **EXCEPT** if in a cleared area of at least 10 feet in diameter and a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher is kept with the operator.
