## Stage 1 Fire Restrictions

You Can Help! Follow these restrictions:

#### **SHOOTING**

**PROHIBITED:** Use of explosives including but not limited to blasting caps, rockets, exploding targets and tracers or incendiary ammunition. (The use of fireworks, flares or other incendiary devices is **ALWAYS** prohibited on federal

#### **CAMPFIRES**

**PROHIBITED:** Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, including charcoal briquette fire.

**PERMITTED:** You CAN have a campfire (including charcoal briquette fire) within permanent fire rings at established campgrounds and picnic areas.



#### **SMOKING**

**PROHIBITED:** Smoking while traveling in timber, brush or grass areas.

**PERMITTED:** Smoking within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is cleared of all flammable materials.







### OTHER RESTRICTIONS

**PROHIBITED:** Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine WITHOUT a spark-arresting device installed. **PERMITTED:** Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine WITH a spark-arresting

**PROHIBITED:** Blasting, welding or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame EXCEPT if in a cleared area of at least 10 feet in diameter and a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher is kept with the operator.
